

Credit by Examination for CHEM 110/111

Credit by examination is a general procedure whereby students can obtain credit for courses by taking a comprehensive examination as described at (<http://senate.psu.edu/policies/42-00.html#42-50>). For the CHEM 110/111 exam given at the start of the semester we follow a slightly different procedure from the one described on that web site. In this case the "Credit by Examination Application" form (including signatures) will be provided to students at the exam site; pre-registration is not required. Students must pay the University's \$120 exam fee by bringing a check payable to "Penn State University" to the exam. Note that this fee must be paid at the time the exam is taken, but the application form need not be obtained ahead of time. Students also should bring their Penn State I.D., pencils, and a scientific, non-programmable calculator (no text storage or communication capabilities allowed) to the exam.
